**PROPOSAL FOR THE ADMISSION OF THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO TO THE OECD SCHEME
FOR THE APPLICATION OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS FOR FRUIT AND VEGETABLES**

This document is submitted to the Council for approval under the written procedure.

1. The Organisation has received an application from The Kingdom of Morocco for admission to the OECD Scheme for the Application of International Standards for Fruit and Vegetables [AGR/CA/FVS(2003)8]. The application was favourably considered by the national representatives [AGR/CA/FVS(2004)1], who invited the Committee for Agriculture to transmit this view to the Council with a recommendation that it approves the admission of the Kingdom of Morocco to the Scheme as a non-Member country.

2. On 26 May 2004, the Committee for Agriculture approved by the written procedure the attached draft Decision set out in the Annex and the Secretary-General accordingly invites the Council to adopt the following draft conclusion:

Having regard to Article 5 a) and c) of the Convention on the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development of 14th December 1960;

Having regard to the Decision of the Council of 8th April 1999 revising the OECD Scheme for the Application of International Standards for Fruit and Vegetables [C(99)10/FINAL];

On the proposal of the Committee for Agriculture;

ADMITS the Kingdom of Morocco to the OECD Scheme for the Application of International Standards for Fruit and Vegetables.
