

THIRD MEETING ON SCALING UP FOR RESULTS

Since we met for the second time on 6 December to discuss Scaling Up for Results, there has been progress at both global and country level in preparing for the increase in aid resources due to come on stream in the next couple of years. This includes a rich and wide-ranging discussion at the DAC High Level Meeting on 5 April which highlighted the commitment to achieve the aid pledges that have been made and to share lessons and approaches as agencies scale up to deliver higher aid volumes. Since then, as agreed at the meeting, the DAC has carried out a survey of DAC members with respect to their future aid allocations. In parallel the Bank has been working with the UNDP, and in consultation with the EC and the IMF, on how to strengthen the aid partnership through the country-based model, and how to move forward practically through a 'Results and Resources' process for an initial set of countries.

The DAC HLM meeting encouraged further work, including a stocktaking at senior official level following the survey of donors' indicative spending plans that we first discussed on 6 December. We now wish to invite you to that stocktaking meeting that will be held in **Paris on June 27**. The meeting will review the global challenges of delivering on the aid pledges in terms of additional long-term resources for development, the indications that some donors have been able to provide about the geographic spread of their future aid, and how to give impetus to scaling up at the country level including through 'Results and Resources' frameworks that would be launched in an initial set of countries. We attach an agenda. There will be papers nearer the time on the country approaches and the results of the survey. We look forward to seeing you in Paris and continuing our dialogue.
