This document provides an outline agenda for a technical workshop of NESTI that will examine an initial, reduced, set of draft substantive chapters and outlines for the revised Oslo Manual. These chapters are being prepared by the editor based on the text contributed by the project team, following the advice of the OM revision steering group (OMSG). Presentation and discussion of outlines for other chapters complete the day's agenda.

The objective of the workshop is to allow an in-depth discussion of the available core drafts and outlines with a view to informing decision-making at the official meeting of the NESTI taking place the following day. This step should lead to the preparation of a full draft manual for discussion and approval in principle at the NESTI meeting that will take place in December 2017, to ensure that the Manual can be submitted for parent committee declassification in January 2018.

The widest possible participation is strongly encouraged for this workshop. Timings are indicative and the structure of the sessions is subject to change.
