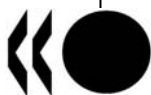

16.30 – 17.30	<p>OPTIONS FOR FINAL WRAP-UP EVENTS EDU/EDPC/MI(2008)4</p> <p><i>At the second meeting of experts on the education of migrants, Mr. Gregory Wurzburg presented the project's draft communication plan and options for country events. Delegates expressed support for a final conference as well as national seminars. The Secretariat noted that it would be financially difficult to support both events. It was agreed that the Secretariat would follow up in writing a decision about how to proceed by mid-2009. This is an opportunity for countries to discuss the pros and cons, as well as the feasibility of the following options:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Series of national seminars (with some not all countries cross-participating) • International conference
