SUMMARY RECORD OF THE EPOC DIALOGUE WITH STAKEHOLDER PARTNERS

31 March 2003

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Agenda Item 1: Welcome and Introductions

1. The **Chair of EPOC**, Helena Cískova, welcomed the participants to the stakeholder dialogue, including representatives of business, trade unions and environmental NGO, as well as EPOC Bureau members and delegates. She explained that the topics for discussion listed on the Agenda [ENV/EPOC(2003)12] had been established in consultation with the stakeholder representatives, based on topics proposed at the November 2002 dialogue and in light of the EPOC agenda. The Agenda can be found in Annex 1.

2. The **Chair** introduced the members of the EPOC Bureau who were participating in the dialogue, and asked the representatives of the three stakeholder groups to introduce their colleagues. A list of participants is attached in Annex 2.

Agenda Item 2: Overview of OECD and its partners' work on implementing the climate change section of the *OECD Environmental Strategy for the First Decade of the 21st Century*, with a focus on domestic policies and actions

3. In order to introduce the main theme of the dialogue – Implementing the climate change section of the *OECD Environmental Strategy for the First Decade of the 21st Century*, with a focus on domestic policies and actions – the **Secretariat** presented a brief overview of work being undertaken in OECD, the International Energy Agency (IEA), the Nuclear Energy Agency (NEA) and the European Conference of the Ministers of Transport (ECMT) on assessment of national policies in this area.

Agenda Item 3: Stakeholder Presentations on the Main Theme

4. Representatives of the **business and industry community** presented the BIAC discussion paper on the main theme which was set out in ENV/EPOC/RD(2003)7. They stressed the need for flexible approaches to implementing the climate change goals set out in the Strategy, which they felt should include technology innovation, market approaches and voluntary instruments. They advised member countries to be cautious about creating short-term time frames for implementation and to avoid barriers to technical innovation. They urged OECD to review costs and benefits of various policy approaches in order to identify the least costly options.

5. A representative of the **environmental NGOs** presented the paper included in ENV/EPOC/RD(2003)8, which was devoted to a discussion of climate change policy coherence in relation to global trade and financial flows. She expressed concerns about public funds being used to subsidise investment in fossil fuel technologies in developing countries and criticised development projects and international financial institutions which did so. On the other hand, she welcomed promising initiatives to address implementation of climate change goals in member countries, especially at the local and state level.

6. A representative of the **trade unions** presented the TUAC discussion paper which was set out in ENV/EPOC/RD(2003)9. He focussed on the implications that climate change mitigation policies will have on employment and called for OECD to analyse the possible impacts on individual sectors and countries in order for countries to be able to respond adequately and equitably to such impacts. TUAC also called for OECD to support improved decision-making through “workplace assessment projects” whereby trade unions and employers undertake joint assessments of workplace performance according to environmental, occupational and social criteria to identify tools for better addressing environmental and social targets in the workplace.

Agenda Item 4: Responses by Members of the EPOC Bureau

7. **Mr. Mats Olsson** (Vice Chair of EPOC) described the Swedish programme for implementing climate change goals which comprised six major groups of instruments to be used by the government, including a carbon tax, legislative initiatives related to energy generation and use, educational campaigns based on local mitigation programmes, investment support programmes for new technologies, an emissions trading programme and support for research.

8. **Ms Judith Ayres** (Vice Chair of EPOC) gave an overview of the four major areas in the United States' programme to mitigate climate change impacts. These included policy development, voluntary programmes, research and international co-operation projects.

Agenda Item 5: General Discussion

9. **The Chair** opened the general discussion by asking participants for further input on initiatives to be taken, both by governments and by stakeholders. The ensuing discussion was wide ranging and included developments in "green" labour agreements; recycling; regulatory approaches; setting of absolute versus relative targets for meeting climate change goals; promoting decoupling economic growth from climate change pressures or emission reduction; and the need to further value changes and political awareness initiatives. In general, participants agreed that dialogue among stakeholders at every stage of work towards implementing climate change goals was necessary to support the decisions that will need to be taken by governments on voluntary and/or regulatory approaches. The current situation, in which a mix of approaches was being applied, would help inform governments and gather the necessary political support for those strong measures and policy approaches which would likely be necessary in the longer term.

10. In summary, participants felt that OECD was fulfilling a useful role by providing a forum for discussion of best practices and policy development and focussing its work on indicators, decoupling, removal of environmentally harmful subsidies and the relationship of environmental impacts with the social and economic dimensions of climate change policies and instruments. The model used by EPOC to involve stakeholders was seen to be useful for shaping national policies as well.

Agenda Item 6: Selected Issues on EPOC Agenda

11. Stakeholder groups requested information on two items from the EPOC meeting agenda. In response, the Secretariat informed the stakeholders of the state of the preparations for the proposed Meeting of EPOC at Ministerial Level in 2004, including the plans to hold consultations between Ministers and stakeholders in conjunction with the meeting. Stakeholders raised the issue of a possible joint statement to be issued in the framework of the meeting.

12. The other item for which stakeholders had requested information was the preparations for the Environment for Europe Ministerial Meeting to be held in Kiev in May 2003. The Secretariat reported on OECD's role in this meeting and made the Room Document, which had been prepared for EPOC, available to stakeholders.

Agenda Item 7: Concluding Comments

13. The **Chair** concluded by thanking participants for their constructive inputs. She indicated that EPOC Bureau members would report back to EPOC on the results of the discussions and invited stakeholders to participate in the high level special session of EPOC on decoupling environmental pressures in the transport sector, in the context of changing unsustainable production and consumption patterns, to be held in conjunction with the next EPOC meeting in November.

Item 1: Welcome and Introductions

1. The Chair of the Environment Policy Committee (EPOC), **Mrs. Helena Cizkova**, will open the Dialogue. Representatives of each of the three groups of stakeholders will then be invited to introduce their colleagues. The issues on the Agenda have been selected in consultation with the stakeholder representatives.

Item 2: Theme of Dialogue

2. The discussion during the Dialogue will focus on a single issue - implementing the climate change section of the OECD Environmental Strategy for the First Decade of the 21st Century, with a focus on domestic policies and actions. As an introduction, **Ms. Jan Corfee** (OECD Environment Directorate) will briefly outline work being undertaken in OECD as part of the implementation of Objective 1 of the Strategy.

Item 3: Stakeholder presentations on the theme

3. Representatives from each of the three stakeholder groups (**BIAC, NGOs, TUAC**) will briefly present their Room Documents on what the stakeholder groups are doing to support improved design and implementation of domestic policies and measures for achieving climate change policy goals.

Item 4: Responses by Members of the EPOC Bureau

4. **Mr. Mats Olsson** and **Ms. Judith Ayres**, EPOC Vice-Chairs, will briefly respond to the points made by the three stakeholder groups in their Room Documents in order to kick off the discussions on the theme.

Item 5: General discussion

5. Following the introductory presentations, the discussion on the theme of the Dialogue will be opened to all participants.

Item 6: Selected issues on the EPOC Agenda

6. In addition to the overall special theme selected for the Dialogue, stakeholder groups have identified two items on the EPOC agenda which they would like to have discussed: 1) the meeting of EPOC at Ministerial Level in 2004 and 2) the Environment for Europe Ministerial Meeting in Kiev in May 2003. The Secretariat (**Ms Amy Plantin** and **Mr. Brendan Gillespie**) will report on the preparations for these two meetings.

7. Stakeholders will be invited to provide brief concluding comments. The Chair of EPOC will indicate how the results of this Dialogue will be reported back to the meeting of EPOC.
