Introduction

The Working Party:

- noted the introductory remarks of the Chair, Mr. Øyvind Lone, and the Environment Director, Mr. Simon Upton;
- adopted the draft agenda [ENV/EPOC/GEP/A(2010)1/REV];
- noted that the Summary Record of the WPEP meeting of 6-8 October 2009 [ENV/EPOC/GEP/M(2010)1/Final] had been adopted through a written procedure;

EPOC'S discussion of Working Parties

The Working Party:

- noted EPOC's discussion of its Working Parties [ENV/EPOC(2010)4/REV2], including the decision to reconstitute the Working Group on Environmental Information and Outlooks (WGEIO) as the Working Party on Environmental Information (WPEI);
- noted that the mandate of the WPEP had been changed to conform with the general template for EPOC Working Party's terms of reference, but that the main responsibilities remained essentially the same;
- noted that the new Working Party structure will become effective as of the 1 January 2011, and that the mandates of EPOC's Working Parties will run to 31 December 2013.

Scheduling and Implementation of EPR Programme

The Working Party:

- noted that the Secretary-General launched the Environmental Performance Reviews of Ireland (3-4 November 2009), Greece (14-15 March 2010) and Luxembourg (30-31 March 2010);
- welcomed such high-level participation in launch events to enhance the visibility and potential impact of EPRs;
- noted that review missions had been made to Portugal (28 February-9 March 2010) and Norway (21-28 March 2010);
- noted the information regarding the planned review missions to the Slovak Republic (26 September-5 October 2010) and Israel (17-25 October 2010);
- noted that some of the countries to be reviewed in the context of the 2011-2012 Programme of Work and Budget [ENV/EPOC(2010)1/ANN1] had still to be identified;
- agreed that, as far as possible, the sequence of countries to be reviewed in the 3rd cycle should follow that of the 2nd cycle, and called on countries to make arrangements with the secretariat to this end [the sequence of 2nd cycle country reviews is presented in Annex 1].

Mid-term Reviews

The Working Party:

- discussed the role and organisation of the mid-term reviews on the basis of the paper prepared by the Secretariat [ENV/EPOC/GEP(2010)4];

- agreed to rename the reports “Mid-term Progress Reports”
- agreed that Mid-Term Progress Reports are not a surrogate for EPRs and should not divert resources from implementing the EPR programme;
- agreed that Mid-Term Progress Reports should be voluntary, based on self-assessment, and with the primary aim of reinvigorating the implementation of the EPR recommendations;
- agreed that countries should use their own reporting format with the minimum requirement of identifying actions taken to implement all of the EPR recommendations;
- invited the Secretariat to prepare a paper suggesting good reporting practices that countries could take into account when preparing their Mid-Term Progress Reports;
- agreed that reviewing countries should help initiate discussion of the country’s Mid-Term Progress Reports in the WPEP, and that a short summary of the discussion should be included in the summary record of the meeting;
- agreed that it should be the choice of the reviewed country whether the Mid-Term Progress Report appears on and/or is linked to on the OECD website, and, when this is the case, it should be made clear that it is a self-assessment and not an OECD report;
- invited countries to indicate to the Secretariat their willingness to prepare a Mid-Term Progress Report [a list of mid-term reviews conducted to date is presented in Annex 2].

Other Business

The Working Party:

- took note of the report by the Chair of Annual Meeting of Sustainable Development Experts (AMSDE) [C(2009)197];
- agreed that the next meeting of the WPEP will be held on 29 November-1 December 2010, with the reviews of Portugal (29 November) and Norway (30 November);
- noted the next meeting of the WGEIO will be held on 23-25 November 2010.

Environmental Performance Review (EPR) of Japan [ENV/EPOC/GEP(2010)1]

The Working Party:

- took note of the introductory statements by Mr. Nobumori Otani, Parliamentary Secretary of the Environment, Ministry of the Environment of Japan, and by Mr. Simon Upton, Environment Director;
- discussed the EPR of Japan on the basis of the “Possible Issues for Discussion” [ENV/EPOC/GEP(2010)2] and introductory statements by the reviewing countries: Korea, Norway and Germany;
- discussed and approved, after amendments, the EPR Assessment and Recommendations [ENV/EPOC/GEP(2010)3] and Room Document 1;
- requested that the Secretariat make the corresponding changes to the EPR main report [ENV/EPOC/GEP(2010)1], in consultation with the Japanese Delegation;
- agreed that the revised report of the EPR of Japan be published under the responsibility of the Secretary-General of the OECD, along with the Assessment and Recommendations approved by the WPEP.
