6. The report "Reallocation: the Role of Budget Institutions" concludes the Reallocation Project of the OECD which started in the autumn of 2002. The report is based on information that the members of the expert group have provided in reply to a questionnaire of December 2002 and on case studies that were discussed during the first meeting of the expert group which took place in February 2003. The report will be presented by the authors Joanne Kelly and Jan-Dirk Kraan.
7. The members of the expert group are encouraged to give their views on the report during the discussion. The OECD Secretariat is interested among other things in the views of the expert group on the usefulness of the micro-economic classification in chapter 4 of the report.
8. The representatives of Canada and the Netherlands will give reactions to the report in view of the experiences of their governments in the area of reallocation.
9. Prof. Daniel Tarschys will give his reaction to the report from the point of view of an external expert. He will place the report in the context of both recent and long-standing research work done in this area and will reflect on the development of budgetary practice and theory.
