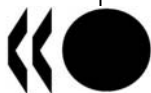

**WORKING PARTY ON TERRITORIAL INDICATORS – 16TH SESSION
9 JUNE 2008– PARIS
SUMMARY RECORD**

Item 1: Approval of the agenda

1. Mr. Dev Virdee, WPTI Chair, introduced the agenda of the 16th Session, which was approved by the Working Party.

Item 2: Approval of the Summary record of the 15th session

2. The Working Party approved the Summary Record of the 15th Session.

Item 3: Opening Remarks by the Chair and Director's Statement

3. The Chair presented the two main themes of the agenda. The first one (described as “thematic work”), aimed at starting a discussion among Delegates on what kind of information the WPTI is envisaging to obtain in the next two years to support regional development policies. Trends in public investment expenditure and public services, defining local community indicators to measure the progress of societies, regional innovation systems and regional migration are four possible directions of work for the WPTI in the next two years. The Secretariat underlined the relevance of regional innovation, trends of public expenditure and accessibility to public services in the TDPC Programme of Work 2009-2010. The other main session, dedicated to the “ongoing work” of this biennium, aimed at discussing the results for the publications “Regions at a glance – 2009 edition” and “The sources of economic growth in OECD regions” and improvements on regional typology.

Item 4: Roundtable on Mapping public investment and public services

4. Two presentations introduced the discussion on the information on the amount of public investment expenditure in regions. The first presentation by the Secretariat highlighted the different types of information collected through the OECD fiscal network. The second presentation by Italy gave an overview of the Italian territorial public accounts database and its uses. A lively discussion followed the presentations with interventions from United States, European Commission, France, Greece, Canada, Norway, underlining the relevance of the theme for the TDPC and the work of the WPTI as well as some challenges in breaking down expenditure by categories and regions. The European Commission informed the Delegates that recently a project has been launched, through Eurostat, to ascertain the existing and possible future availability of regional government expenditure information in European countries. Further information on the topic will be provided at the end of 2008. The WPTI agreed to proceed with a pilot phase, involving a limited number of countries, to explore the availability of information on regional public expenditure and how some of the issues raised in the roundtable are addressed in these countries. In 2009, on the basis of the results of this first phase, the WPTI will define the relevant dimensions to be measured and decide how to proceed in a more systematic way.

Item 5: Assessing local communities indicators to measure the progress of societies

5. The Secretariat (Statistics Directorate) presented the outline of a project to develop a handbook for local community progress indicators. The project involves different OECD Directorates together with the Council of Europe, the United States Community Indicators Consortium and other organizations active in this field. The foreseen engagement of the WPTI includes the endorsement of the handbook. The WPTI

expressed its interest in participating in the development of the handbook, discussing relevant issues in informal meetings as well as reviewing drafting chapters. In addition the role of the WPTI in the developing of the handbook on local community indicators should also be to influence National Governments in making better use of data at local level carrying out (survey and /or administrative data).

Item 6: Measuring regional innovation

6. This session was focused on the use of innovation indicators at the regional level. The first presentation by the Secretariat on the *OECD Regional Review of Innovation: North of England, UK* raised the issue of how the indicators are being used to evaluate regional performance based on different benchmarks from across OECD regions as well as the availability and limits of the data for innovation reviews. Another presentation on *Innovation Indicators in Regions at a Glance* highlighted the status of data collection and some preliminary results that will be later published in the 2009 edition. A third presentation was made by the Secretariat (Directorate for Science, Technology and Industry) on the Regionalised Patent database. Interventions from the EC DG Regio, Italy, Greece and France followed the presentations. The discussion underlined the importance of being cautious in interpreting the available innovation indicators. For instance, since not all innovations are patented it could be useful to investigate if sectoral productivity can serve as a proxy for, say, management innovation or supply chain innovation. Greece suggested the use of spatial autocorrelation for future quantitative analysis of spill-over effects.

Item 7: Regional migration: determinants and impact on regional development; a case study from Germany

7. Antonia Milbert (WPTI Delegate Germany) presented a study on the dynamics of natural and migration balance and their impacts on regional growth in German regions in the past years and projections for the near future. The study also analysed the role of gender in regional migration of youth with a focus on the highly educated labour force. A lively discussion followed the presentation with interventions from United Kingdom, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, United States, European Commission and Austria. Countries mentioned different methods developed to measure migration trends and suggested to discuss some of these methods more in depths in the next WPTI meeting.

Item 8: OECD Regions at a Glance 2009: Preliminary draft

8. The Secretariat presented the table of contents and some results from selected chapters of “*Regions at a Glance - 2009*”. The Secretariat informed the WPTI on data needs and the timetable in order to complete the publication by December 2008. Delegates provided significant feedback on the draft of Sections I and II of *Regions at a glance* and expressed their interest in the development of interactive mapping to link to the regional database. The final draft of the publication *Regions at a glance – 2009* will be sent to Delegates before the next WPTI meeting and will be published on time for the Ministerial meeting of 2009.

Item 9: The Sources of Economic Growth in OECD Regions

9. The Sources for Economic Growth in OECD regions will be published as a manuscript at the end of 2008 with three main sections. The final version of Section 1 and 2 of the manuscript were presented at the 16th WPTI meeting and a preliminary version of Section 3 distributed as a room document. Delegates provided substantial feedback on all three sections. It was agreed to have the final approval of the first two sections via e-mail, while the final version for Section 3 will be presented in the 17th WPTI on December 2008.

Item 10: Typology of regions

10. Mr Dev Virdee (Chair of WPTI) briefed Delegates on a proposal to develop a definition of metropolitan regions under the guidance of the Greater London Authority. Mr. Lewis Dijkstra (European Commission) presented a paper on the performance of rural regions classified according to proximity to cities. This new classification of regions is based on a combination of the OECD typology into predominantly rural, intermediate and predominantly urban regions combined with the driving time to the closest city of at least 50 000 inhabitants. Because of lack of time, the discussion on the feasibility of extending the combined methodology proposed by the EC as well as the proposal on measuring metropolitan regions was very limited; Delegates were invited to send additional comments to the Secretariat.
