NEW HEAD OF THE YUGOSLAV DELEGATION TO OECD

- Ambassador Zarko Papic has taken up his post as Yugoslav Permanent Representative to the OECD, succeeding Ambassador Tomislav Jankovic.
- Born in Sarajevo in 1947, Ambassador Papic graduated in planning from the economics faculty at the University of Belgrade where he was also awarded a Ph.D.. Prior to his present appointment, he served from 1986 to 1989 as Director-General of the Federal Planning Office. From 1982 to 1986, he was Minister for Science and Informatics in the Republic of Serbia and a member of the Executive Assembly of Serbia.
- Earlier in his career Dr. Papic was on the staff of the Institute for Investment Economics and a professor at the economics faculty of the University of Novi Sad, lecturing in planning. His published works include eight books, and numerous papers and articles.
- Ambassador Papic is married, with one son.
